Pre-Kindergarten

Children begin learning in their native language so they can access ideas, express themselves, and fall in love with learning from day one. Throughout the year, they are introduced to their second language.

Why this matters

At ages 3–5, confidence and comprehension are everything. Early wins in the home language make it easier to learn and grow in a second language.



Kindergarten - 2nd Grade

Literacy is taught in a student's native language to ensure strong foundational skills. Students also enjoy dedicated class time to learn the target language.

What you'll see

Building fundamental skills in a child's native language ensures they have the proper foundation to acquire their second language.



3rd - 5th Grade

All subjects are taught in 50/50 English and Spanish, now in longer six-week blocks.

Outcomes

By upper elementary, students aren't just code-switching words. They're shifting academic mindsets across languages. This is the bridge from "learning a language" to learning in two languages.

Joyfully Catholic

At Escuela, we offer a joyfully Catholic faith formation program. From daily bilingual prayer and weekly Mass to sacramental preparation, retreats, and a school-wide day of service, we form students who are not just academically excellent, but faith-centered community leaders.

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Middle School

- Most Denver high schools are English-only, so our core courses are taught in English, setting students up to thrive as their education progresses.
- Spanish skills are honed through advanced Spanish classes.
- Seal of Biliteracy: Before graduation, 8th graders can test for a Seal of Biliteracy Pathway Certificate showing high schools that they're already on the path to earning the official Seal of Biliteracy. This is also an impressive achievement for college applications.
- Electives: We offer options like Art, Music, Robotics, Debate, and Podcasting, and these courses are offered in English and Spanish to keep skills active and meaningful.

Results

Graduates arrive in high school fully prepared for honors-level work in both English and Spanish, opening doors to AP credit and real-world opportunities.
